

## Career Development Experience: Code Nation Internship

PROJECT OVERVIEW	
<b>Career Development Experience Title</b>	Code Nation Internship
<b>School</b>	North Grand High School
<b>Industry Partner(s)</b>	Local Chicago tech companies including Groupon, Grubhub, Google
<b>Endorsement Area</b>	Information Technology
<b>Description of CDE</b>	<p>School works with an external partner – Code Nation. Code Nation, volunteers from partner as a tech company joins class remotely to instruct students on CSS, HTML, jQuery and JavaScript to build a fully interactive website.</p> <p>Year 1 students are focused on skill-building through a series of 7 projects to practice the languages and develop a personal portfolio site. Students also attend field trips to view the opportunities at local tech companies.</p> <p>Internship is part of a 2-year program that provides opportunities for real-world coding education and experience. Participants learn CSS, HTML, jQuery and JavaScript after school 3 hours per week. Students also participate in field trips and hackathons. During students 2<sup>nd</sup> year in the program, they complete an in-person internship at a tech company one day a week to complete actual websites for partners.</p>
<b><u>Essential Employability/ Technical Competencies</u></b>	Participants learn CSS, HTML, jQuery and JavaScript
<b>Credit and/or Compensation Provided to Participants</b>	Students receive school credit.
<b>Delivery Model &amp; Location/ Platform</b>	Hybrid. Industry partners join remotely for classroom component and students attend their internship in-person at the employer site.
