IDEAS FOR INSPIRATION: TEAM-BASED CHALLENGES

Health Sciences and Technology



Health and Well-Being	Review and analyze local needs to determine a focus area to improve residents' health and well-being. Coordinate and develop promotional material for an event, initiative, or program related to this focus area — this can be explored as a Mental Health campaign for their peers as well within a participant's own educational setting.
Changing Patient Conditions	Given a set of unidentified patient data (broken up in stages from first diagnosis to final treatment) — monitor, record, and report symptoms and changes in their condition and suggest a plan of care.
Technical Documentation	Review technical documentation of support issues for processes, systems, applications, computers, networks, and other devices within an organization - identify problems and develop solutions.
Health Insurance	Design a plan for finding the best health insurance based on an individual's personal/family need and whether they are employed (full-/part-time), a student, or unemployed. Compare health plans and explain costs/benefits of choosing one plan over the other.
Public Health	Explore public health crises such as drinking water quality and lead poisoning by reviewing local sources on what is being done in the community to alleviate a public health crisis and make recommendations for what can be done.
