IDEAS FOR INSPIRATION: TEAM-BASED CHALLENGES

Information Technology

Equipment Issues	Troubleshoot equipment issues and make recommendations for maintenance, upgrades, replacement parts, new equipment, etc.
Security Risks	Assess security risks, especially any unusual bugs or other undiagnosed IT issues, and identify meaningful solutions to mitigate.
Ethics and Privacy	Identify and make recommendations to address ethical and privacy issues within an emerging system or process that captures data.
Root Cause Analysis	Perform a review to determine the root cause of a problem or event and based on this analysis provide solutions on how to systemically prevent future issues.
Training/Protocol	Determine a need for awareness/education of a process and develop training on how to use/draft protocol.
