<b>Brief Event Description</b> (include any links to resources and materials as you are able)	Elm Middle school teachers developed and improved curriculum for a series of nine trimester courses on careers that include employer engagement on student projects, three of which to run each year in grades 6, 7, and 8. Students will take one career course during each trimester that are pass/fail and receive 1-credit. Each course has a team of three teachers, of which two will focus on curriculum development and one will focus on employer participation. Teacher lessons will include information on the related career clusters and a structured schedule of business-partner speakers coming to the classrooms to engage in project activity mentoring with students.

<b>Preparation Activities</b> <b>before the Event</b> (include any links to resources and materials as you are able)	Students complete interest surveys to determine courses to offer. Curriculum continuously supports students to learn about and evaluate their options across a variety of career opportunities which they will capture in electronic portfolios.	Courses are designed from 5 <sup>th</sup> grade career interest surveys. Teacher members focusing on employer participation from each career course team will solicit local employers and develop long-term relationships for building projects and interacting with students.		



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Reflection/Follow-up Activities after the Event (include any links to resources and materials as you are able) Students add to electronic student portfolio that includes a project from each of the 9 courses and will be completed by 8 <sup>th</sup> grade to support their transition to high school.	Continued development of a group of local employers with at least one for each course. 8 <sup>th</sup> graders work with the middle school College and Career Counselor to secure work permits and work at the Park District in the summer.
